Let's get right into the most important news:

We're thrilled to announce that we will be hosting a conference next year!

The international conference will have a focus on Environment and Society, and we are looking for submissions investigating the incentives, restrictions, attitudes, beliefs, and psychological dispositions that underlie human-environment interactions.

Our questionnaires are now online!

You can now find the German questionnaires from all GLEN surveys completed so far on our [website](#). This includes the survey programs for the recruitment and starter surveys, as well as our first panel waves 1a and 1b and one inter-wave survey. Both the starter and the inter-wave surveys include experiments available for analysis after publication of the datafiles.

Publication of the questionnaires as of now gives a good possibility for pre-registering your research with GLEN data before the data will be released – an opportunity which is often not possible when using secondary, third-party data.

What you need to know about our release next year:

We are already busy preparing our first data release and are happy to announce that around June 2026, the first Scientific Use File (SUF) of the GLEN study will be available through the GESIS Data Archive.

Details will follow in our next newsletter, so stay tuned.

Lastly, just a small insight into what is happening right now...

Currently in the field: Wave 1b – Our first survey rotation is almost done!

As of November 11th, we have started the second wave of our study and have thus almost completed the first round of data collection in our panel program.
