Our first data release is here! Here's what you need to know:

Welcome back to the GLEN newsletter! We have been busy behind the scenes, and we are thrilled to finally share some exciting news with you:

Our first scientific-use file is online!

This is our biggest milestone yet: the first GLEN data release has just been released and is now available online.

The dataset includes data from five survey waves collected between November 2024 and January 2026, drawn from a register-based sample of the adult population in Germany. It covers a broad range of topics:

- Environmental attitudes and social norms
- Environmental behavior
- Political attitudes and policy support
- Environmental inequality

Release 1.0 contains the Recruitment and Starter Survey, Waves 1a and 1b, and one Inter-Wave Survey. Experiments are embedded in both the Starter and Inter-Wave Surveys and are available for analysis.

We hope researchers from a wide range of environmental and social science disciplines will find new and exciting insights in the data.
